Call to Order

Questions and Comments from the Board

Chairwoman Rennie announced an advisory from CISA had been issued Friday pertaining to a court case, but the election system and process of Erie County were in full compliance. The Election Board takes great pride in the integrity of the process, and doesn't leave things to chance. She stated they welcome watchers as an integral part of the election process, and it is also the job of the board members. She stated the board has more duties than just that, going back to their oath of office.
