Carla Arnone: Ms. Arnone stated it was World Children's Day and Transgender Day of Remembrance and invited everyone to a service at Erie's Unitarian Universalist Congregation that evening.

Cindy Treiber, Edinboro: Mrs. Treiber requested the development of a County Wide Police Partnership. She stated police were notified but non-responsive to these problems.

Deonna Chatfield: Ms. Chatfield expressed concern on behalf of the youth, and fear and hurt due to the death of Marchello Woodard. She stated that youth do not trust law enforcement.

Scott Rastetter, Washington Township: Mr. Rastetter expressed opinions on the death of Mr. Woodard, support of the Community College, and chamber's set-up.

Brenda Spears: Ms. Spears stated the Justice for Chello Coalition would protest no matter what the weather.

Jeff Gross, North East Borough: Mr. Gross stated the voter differential in the county executive election was a call for change, and that it was correlated to Woodard case.
